Submission guidelines

Students of the Faculty are invited to submit original and unpublished papers, which are not under review in any other conference or journal. All papers will be peer reviewed by the program committee based on their originality, significance, methodological soundness, and clarity of exposition.

Submitted papers must be written in English and should be in Microsoft Word format. They must follow the instructions in the template file, available in Microsoft Word format at:

Submissions must be between 5 and 10 pages (A4 size), incorporating the title page (title, abstract and keywords), all text, references, figures and tables. These guidelines are strict: papers failing to adhere to the guidelines (by being more than 10 pages, altering margins or not following the template) will be rejected without consideration of their merits.

Submissions imply the willingness of at least one author to register, attend the conference, and present the paper.
